

## HEPATOBIILIARY SURGERY

### PROCEDURE A ( RM 4401 - RM 4800 )

- 1 General procedure Extracorporeal hepatic assistance (liver dialysis)
- 2 Liver Hemi-hepatectomy
- 3 Liver Extended hemi-hepatectomy
- 4 Liver Segmental resection of the liver
- 5 Liver Spleno-renal shunt
- 6 Liver Porto-caval shunt
- 7 Liver Mesenterico-caval shunt
- 8 Liver Meso-atrial shunt
- 9 Liver En-bloc resection of lesions of the liver and adjoining viscera/tissues
- 10 Bile duct Radical choledochectomy
- 11 Bile duct Biliary reconstruction for complex bile duct injuries
- 12 Gall bladder Radical cholecystectomy
- 13 Gall bladder En-bloc resection of lesions of the biliary system and adjoining viscera/tissues
- 14 Ampulla of Vater Transduodenal ampullectomy
- 15 Pancreas Whipple's pancreaticoduodenectomy with distal gastrectomy
- 16 Pancreas Pylorus preserving pancreaticoduodenectomy
- 17 Pancreas Duodenal preserving excision of head of pancreas
- 18 Pancreas En-bloc resection of lesions of the pancreas and adjoining viscera/tissues

- 19 Liver Lateral hepatectomy
- 20 Liver Non-anatomical resection of the liver
- 21 Liver Hepatic debridement and haemostasis
- 22 Liver Hepatic artery reconstruction
- 23 Liver Portal vein reconstruction
- 24 Bile duct Excision choledochal cyst and biliary reconstruction
- 25 Bile duct Biliary reconstruction for simple bile duct injuries
- 26 Pancreas Distal pancreatectomy (excision of tail of pancreas with or without excision of spleen)
- 27 Pancreas Total pancreatectomy (with or without excision of duodenum)

### PROCEDURE C ( RM 2801 - RM 3600 )

- 28 Bile duct Choledochectomy with biliary reconstruction
- 29 Bile duct Revision of bilio-enteric anastomosis
- 30 Bile duct Primary repair of bile duct
- 31 Bile duct Choledochoplasty (Repair/Closure of bile duct fistula)
- 32 Gall bladder Cholecystectomy and bile duct exploration (with operative cholangiogram or choledochoscopy)

- 33 Gall bladder Cholecystectomy and bile duct exploration (Laparoscopic) with operative cholangiogram or choledochoscopy
- 34 Ampulla of Vater Transduodenal sphincteroplasty
- 35 Pancreas Pancreatic debridement and haemostasis
- 36 Pancreas Pancreatic debridement and necrosectomy
- 37 Pancreas Removal of calculus from pancreatic duct
- 38 Pancreas Pancreaticojejunostomy
- 39 Pancreas Pancreatic ductoplasty
- 40 Pancreas Anastomosis of pancreas (duct) to stomach
- 41 Pancreas Anastomosis of pancreas (duct) to small bowel

- 42 General procedure Gastro-enteric bypass (gastro-jejunostomy)
- 43 General procedure Entero-enteric bypass (duodeno-jejunostomy, jejuno-jejunostomy)
- 44 Liver Intraoperative (including laparoscopic) ablation of liver tumors (chemical or thermal ablation)
- 45 Liver Enucleation of liver lesion
- 46 Liver Hepatic exploration (hepatotomy) for removal of foreign body
- 47 Bile duct Bilio-enteric bypass (Roux-en-Y choledochojejunostomy/ choledochoduodenostomy or segment III bypass)
- 48 Bile duct Excision of cystic duct remnant
- 49 Gall bladder Cholecystectomy with or without operative cholangiogram
- 50 Gall bladder Cholecystectomy (laparoscopic) with or without operative cholangiogram
- 51 Gall bladder Cholecystostomy (including laparoscopic)
- 52 Gall bladder Cholecysto-enteric bypass
- 53 Pancreas Cystogastrotomy (including laparoscopic)
- 54 Pancreas Cystojejunostomy (including laparoscopic)
- 55 Pancreas Excision of pancreatic fistula
- 56 Pancreas Closure of pancreatic fistula
- 57 Pancreas Local excision of pancreatic mass
- 58 Duodenum Duodenal resection with duodeno-duodenostomy or duodeno-jejunostomy
- 59 Duodenum Partial duodenal excision and primary closure

- 68 Endoscopy Endoscopic retrograde cholangio-pancreatography (ERCP) – Ampullectomy
- 69 Endoscopy ERCP – Endoscopic sealing of pancreatic fistula
- 70 Endoscopy ERCP – Endoscopic drainage of pancreatic pseudocyst
- 71 Endoscopy ERCP – Therapeutic endoscopic procedures post-Bilroth II gastrectomy
