PROCEDURE A (RM 4401 - RM 4800)

- 1 Brachytherapy of prostate
- 2 Radical prostatectomy, reconstruction of urinary bladder neck including bilateral pelvic lymphadenectomy (Laparoscopic/Robotic)
- 3 Radical cystectomy with construction of continent pouch/neo urinary bladder

PROCEDURE B (RM 3601 - RM 4400)

- 4 Radical prostatectomy, reconstruction of urinary bladder neck including bilateral pelvic lymphadenectomy (open)
